EVERY GOOD & PERFECT GIFT by Josh Manning


When we think about the things that God has given to us, could anything be more valuable than the gift of His Son, Jesus? If we categorize the blessings that come from God, in the first case, there are the gifts that many call the gifts of general grace. Jesus taught about God's general care for His creation often: "Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?" (Matthew 6:25 -26). One of the reasons we call these type of gifts "general" is because, as the Lord taught, "He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust" (Matthew 5:45), meaning they fall on everyone—they are blessings built into the system.

There is, however, another category of gifts. These are the heavenly gifts and blessings that only come to those who belong to God in a covenant relationship. While it would be easy to battle over semantics at this point and argue back and forth about the fact that, as Creator, God is Father of all (there is some merit and validity to this thought), for this article we are going to say that we are talking specifically about the special blessings that come to those who are "In Christ Jesus." What do we mean when we speak about being "in Christ"? (I encourage you to do a New Testament study on being "in Christ" and "in Jesus"). Being in Jesus, to a large degree, is synonymous with belonging to God, being redeemed, having your sins washed away, having obeyed the gospel, being added to the church, and having been baptized for the remission of sins (to name a few). These New Testament phrases all speak to the environment of salvation in Jesus by faith. And to the one who has been baptized, has been added to the Lord's body (which is His church), has had his or her sins washed away, and now stands justified before God in Jesus, God gives special blessings.

And yet, we must acknowledge that before God could bless you in Jesus Christ His Son, He first had to give the gift of Jesus. This is why I would say that the greatest blessing is the gift of our Lord Jesus the Christ. Paul wrote, "For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him" (Romans 5:6-9). You and I did not deserve such a gift. Our actions could never have earned such a gift. Knowing this, grace was freely given: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved" (John 3:16-17). God's gift of Jesus is the greatest example of the gift that keeps on giving. He is the gift through Whom the riches of God's grace are eternally given. Father, we thank you for the gift of Jesus!
