THEME FOR 2024: DISCIPLESHIP ON DISPLAY

By This All Will Know That You Are My Disciples by Josh Manning

Does God care who you marry? It might surprise you to know that the question of *who should I marry*? appears in a number of places throughout the Bible. Take for instance, Genesis 24:3. Abraham makes his servant promise to select a wife for Isaac from a certain place. Abraham cared who Isaac married. The stipulation was made, *"you will not take a wife for my son from the daughters of the Canaanites."* This sets the stage for the future nation of Israel and the laws that Moses would give to the descendants of Abraham—namely that they would not intermarry with the people of the land. God commanded Israel to drive out the inhabitants of Canaan. They were to keep themselves separate from the Gentile nations and avoid becoming like them. Because of the importance of being different from the idolatrous nations around them, God repeatedly forbad the Israelites from intermarrying with non-Israelites (cf. Exodus 34:10-16; Judges 3:1-7; Nehemiah 13:23-27). Passages like Judges 3 illustrate that when the Israelites entered into covenants with idol worshipers, they adopted the sinful characteristics of the pagans rather than leading the lost to Yahweh (read 1Kings 11:1-10 for another example).

The Law of Moses and the Old Testament has much to say about the people of God only marrying other believers (i.e. Israelites). What about the New Testament? Well first of all, when it comes to the teachings of Jesus, while He did teach on marriage occasionally (cf. Matthew 19:1-10), we have to remember His context of ministry: *"But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law"* (Galatians 4:4). Jesus lived and died under a Jewish system. So, if we are looking for scriptures speaking to the idea of Christians and whether or not they should marry non-Christians, we have to look to the writings of the Lord's apostles. I suggest studying 1Peter and Paul's writings to the Corinthian church.

As we think about the question, "As a Christian, who should I marry?", I want to remind you of our theme passage for the year: (John 13:34-35). Jesus tells His disciples, "*A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.*" A Christian is supposed to live according to the example of Jesus. Though we are imperfect, our faith motivates us to submit to the authority of God's word and the perfect example of Jesus. Thus, in a marriage where you have two Christians joined to each other, ideally, what should exist is the mutual encouragement to be like Jesus toward one another. Both husband and wife should care for each other according to the New Commandment. When we add to this New Commandment the marriage directions of Paul in Ephesians 5:22-33, what we should see is a relationship of gospel emulation—husband and wife behaving toward the other as Jesus has called us to live.

Now what happens when I remove the *foundation of faith in Jesus* from my marriage? Well, I cannot expect my spouse to understand that marriage is a relationship defined and directed by the love of Jesus if that individual is not a believer. The wisdom of marrying "only in the Lord" is ancient wisdom that goes back to the examples of the Old Testament (1Corinthians 7:39; 10:11). We should heed God's word and build our lives according to His wise ways.


